

CAREER COUNSELLING WORKSHOP



Grade I-II celebrated Pet Day on 25th September. The students who have pets shared their thoughts and briefed to other classmates. It was indeed fun full day for all of them.




SENSE DAY CELEBRATION








SCIENCE ACTIVITIES

Grade III - To identify the different types of birds around us. Grade IV students performed activity on First Aid Box. The main aims of first aid are to preserve life, prevent harm, and promote recovery.




Grade IV - Students performed experiment of Hover Craft. Purpose was to examine the use of air to reduce friction in a hovercraft. Students enjoyed the session a lot.



GRADE V - Science is all about exploring, discoveries and learning through practical. With this approach little scientists of Grade V at Anand Niketan Maninagar School performed Science Lab activity on Formation of rocks and learnt how rocks are formed.



GRADE VI - The young and very curious little scientists of ANM performed various science activities and observed the changes taking place. Also they analyzed whether the changes can be reversed or not. So is the name of our today's activity.



GRADE VII - The practical was demonstrated by the teacher in an online session and the students performed it side by side. This practical is about Lungs model and based on topic Respiration in Organisms. By this practical, students learn the structure of our lungs and the mechanism of breathing.



Grade VIII - Anand Niketanites ever grabs the opportunity then and there thus participating in engrossing activities and creating lively atmosphere of the physical classroom to excel one's skill. Grade VIII students learnt Hydraulic arm model which gives understanding of Pressure, Hydraulic systems are used in countless applications. 









Design thinking is to build one's capacity to ideate and innovate by adopting and practicing certain mindset. Thus students of grade VIII & IX ANM learnt about design thinking in ATL Tinkering Lab. Students were able to design prototype for the problems they have identified in their surroundings followed by learning about what is design thinking and the five stages of design thinking.



SUBJECT ACTIVITIES

Grade I & II - Learning through play is the best way for kids to learn. Bangles and Rajma – Math Activity was conducted on 20th October 2021. Through this activity, the teacher had introduced the concept of multiplication by forming equal groups to make them understand that multiplication is just repeated addition.


Grade III - Hands on activities are an awesome way for students to engage in exploratory activities and develop a real understanding of difficult math concepts. When students create their own fraction strips they develop an understanding of unit fractions and relationships between different fractions.



Grade III - Children enjoyed this activity- QUIZIZZ a lot. They were recalling about the different organs, organ systems and their functions which they had learnt and understood in the previous lecture.



Grade III - To study about the Four Metros of India, their culture, Places of interests, Location, Climate and history. Questions were asked based on the four metros of India and students participated enthusiastically. They learned about the history, climate, places of interest, location, culture.




Grade IV - Cube and Cuboid making activity was conducted to give spatial understanding of 3D shapes to students. Students have drawn a net of 3-dimensional figure on a plane paper or cardboard that can be cut out and folded to form a 3-dimensional shape.



Grade V - Scavenger hunt activity allows kids to practice problem-solving in a tangible way. It helps to reinforce and act-out methods they have been taught by parents or teachers in a physical way, leading to increased retention of the lessons. Scavenger hunts are easy to customize to your child's abilities and interests.



Grade V - In CODING, sequence is a basic algorithm: A set of logical steps carried out in order. Computers need instructions in the form of an algorithm in order to complete a desired task, and this algorithm must have the correct order of steps, or sequence. Students have enjoyed the session.




Grade VI Speaking Activity: With speaking fluency activities, it often doesn't matter what vocabulary and grammar students use and whether it's accurate or not. The learning outcome is for students to gain confidence in speaking English. GRADE III - MORAL- VALUE YOUR MOM. GIVE RESPECT TO HER.




