DEVELOPING SELF-CONFIDENCE

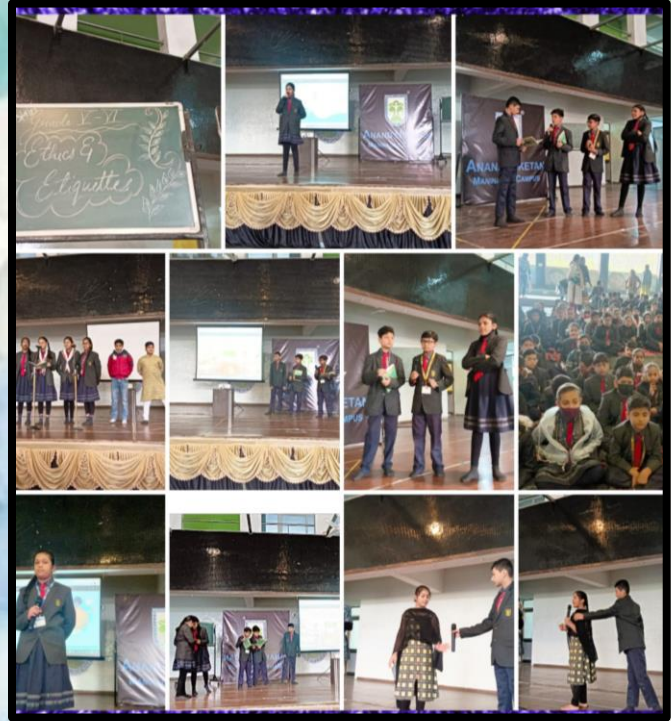
"Self-confidence - having a belief in yourself and your abilities".

WHAT YOU CHOOSE TODAY, YOU BECOME TOMORROW

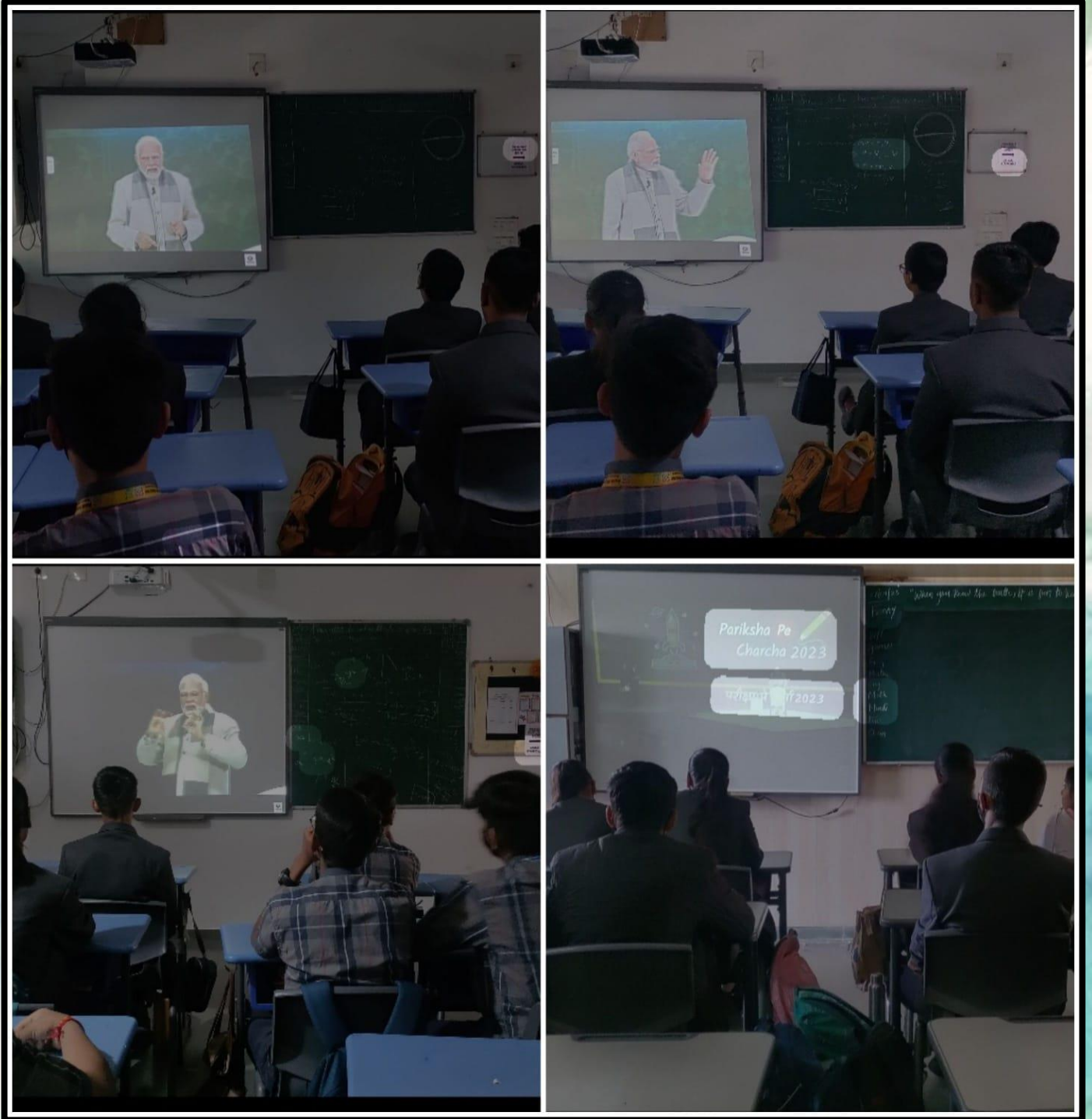
"What you choose today you will become tomorrow" - This is a time of investment. Investing is about making decisions in the present that will have a major impact on your future.

ENGLISH ACTIVITIES

Students of **Grade VIII** made model of solar system where they understand wherefrom we came from, where we are going, and how physics works under conditions which are impossible to recreate on Earth.

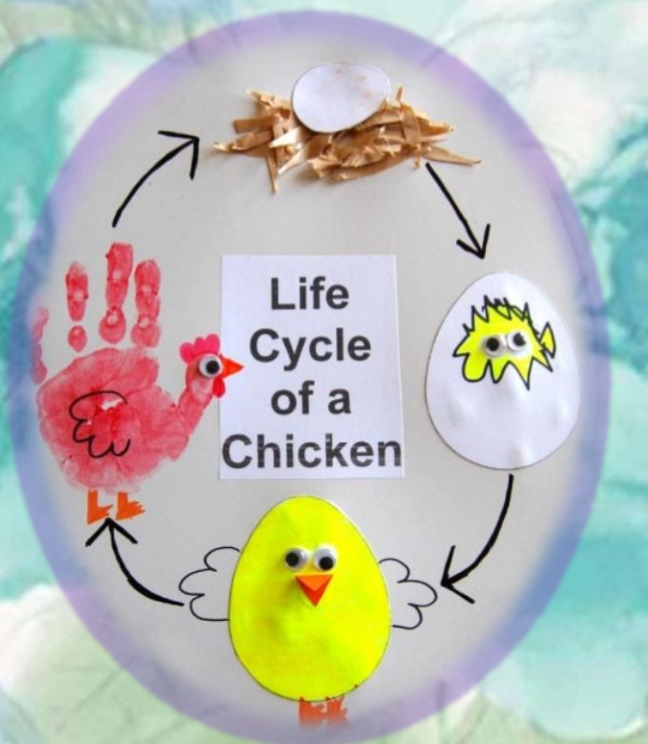
CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

The delightful celebration included children coming in red and white colour party dress, having pastries, dancing and sharing the merriment together. The kids were excited to see the Santa in the class.

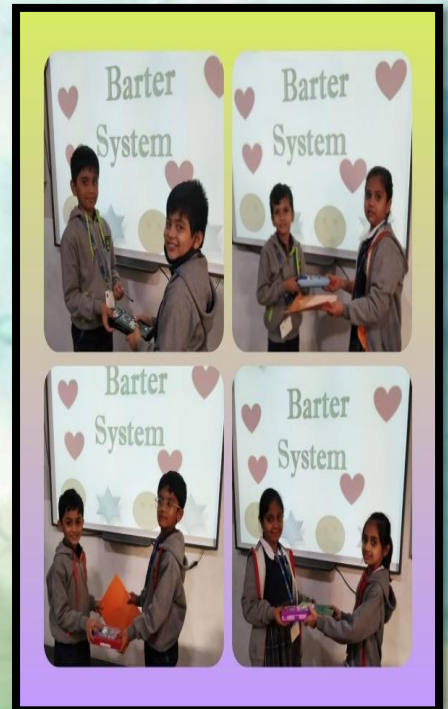
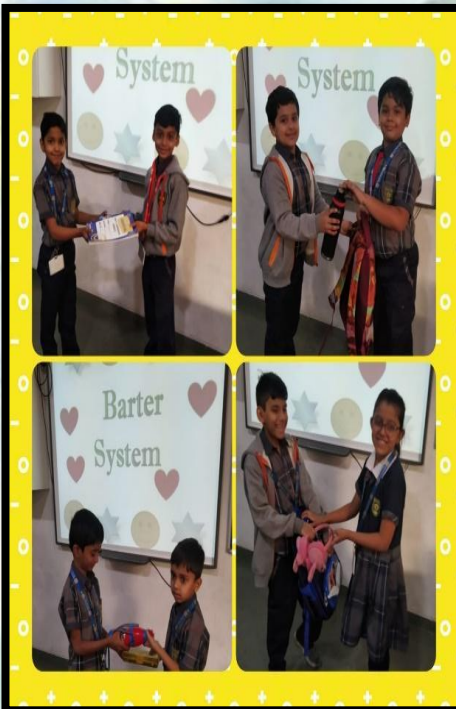


FUN LOVING ACTIVITIES

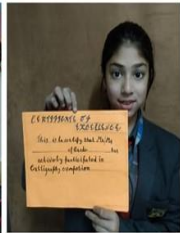

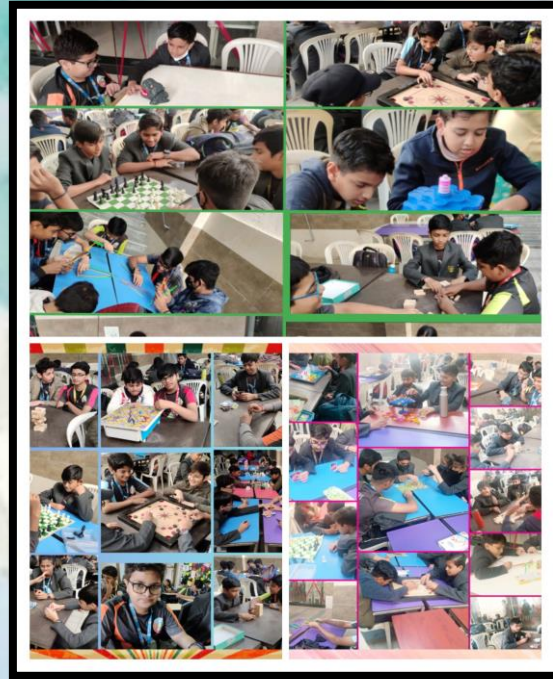
A TOUR - 'CLUB ACTIVITIES'

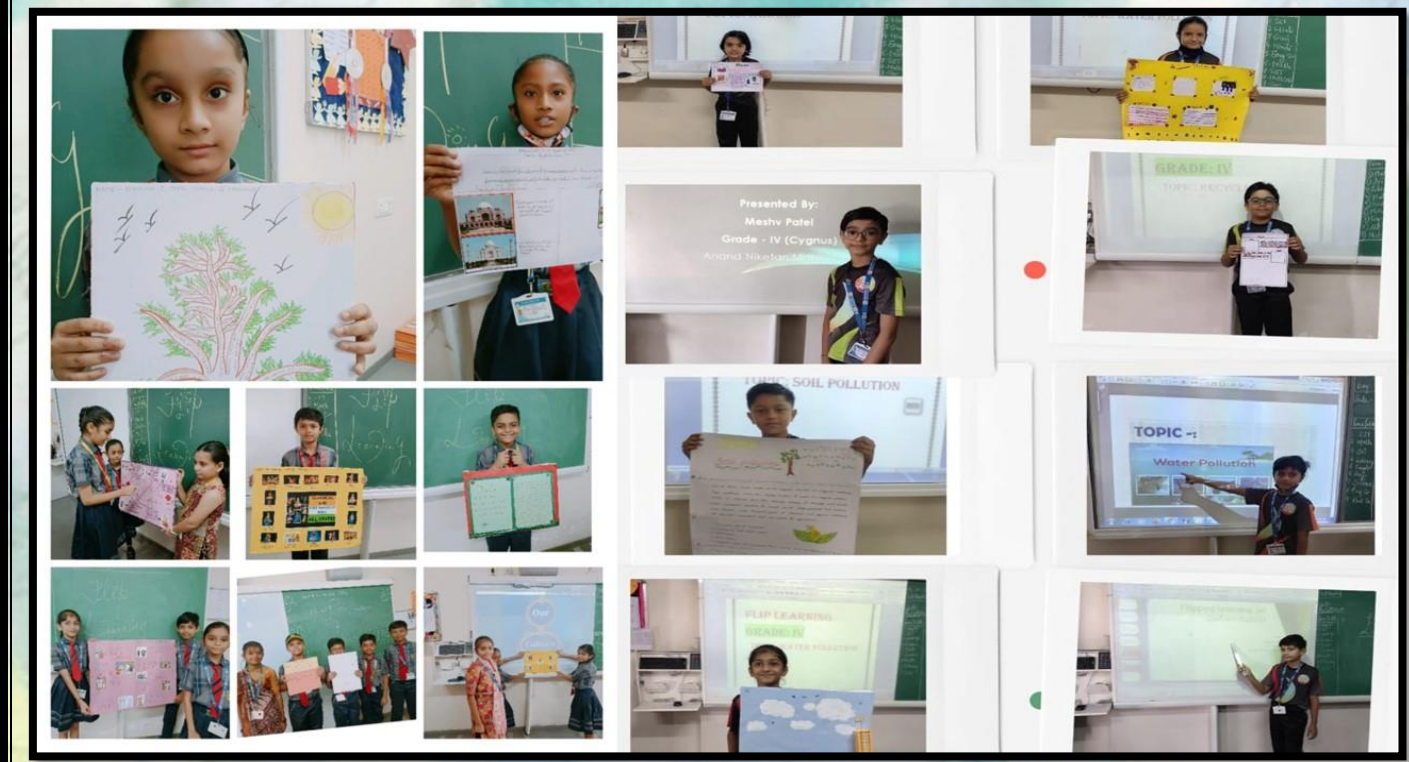

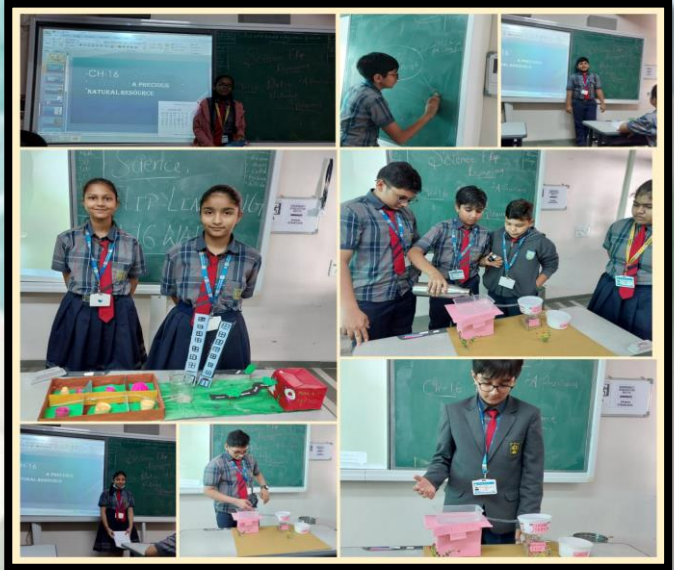


GLIPMSES OF FLIP LEARNING SESSIONS
