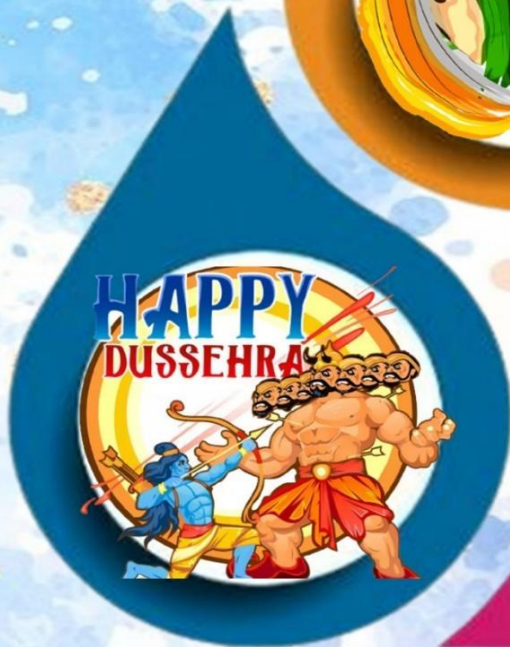

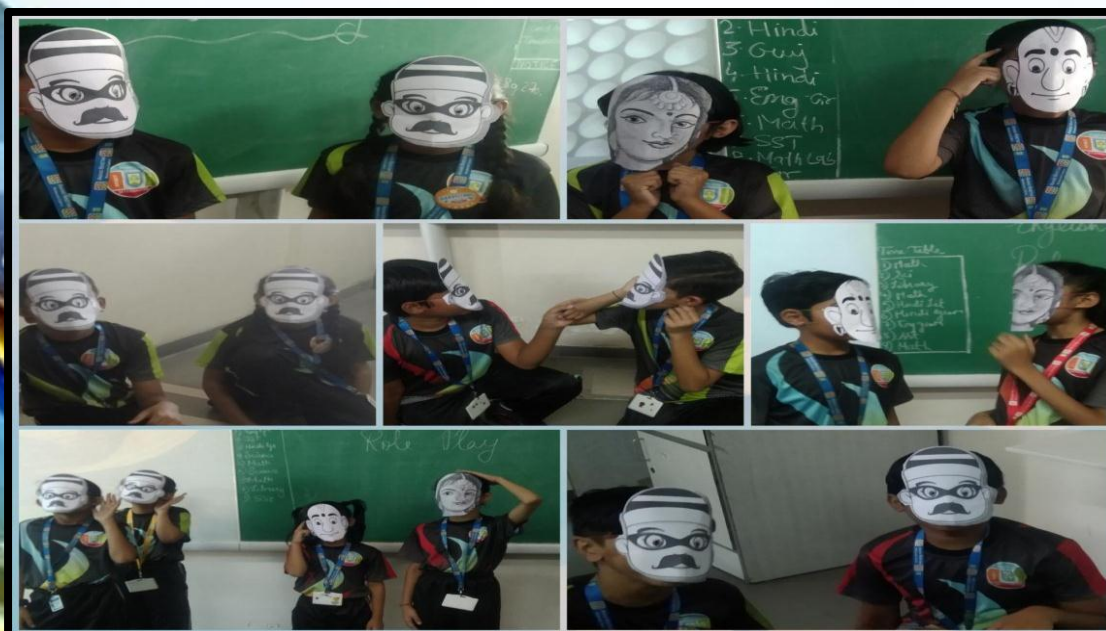
## SUBJECT ACTIVITY

### ENGLISH ACTIVITY

Gender, Proper noun, Common noun activity was conducted for Grade III to make students aware of proper and common noun and to recognize the genders. To make students well versed in writing and communication skills with the proper usage of proper and common noun.



Role play is beneficial for developing vocabulary and language, role play develops communication skills as they communicate with each other with confidence. Students of Grade IV performed the role play to understand the concept, this also helped to write dialogue writing.





## SCIENCE ACTIVITY

Grade I and II students learnt about different festivals through 'Celebrate Festivals' kit and about the work of different helpers through 'Society Helpers' activity of science kit.



## WEIGHT BALANCE ACTIVITY

Students performed the experiment on Respiratory system and learnt the functioning.





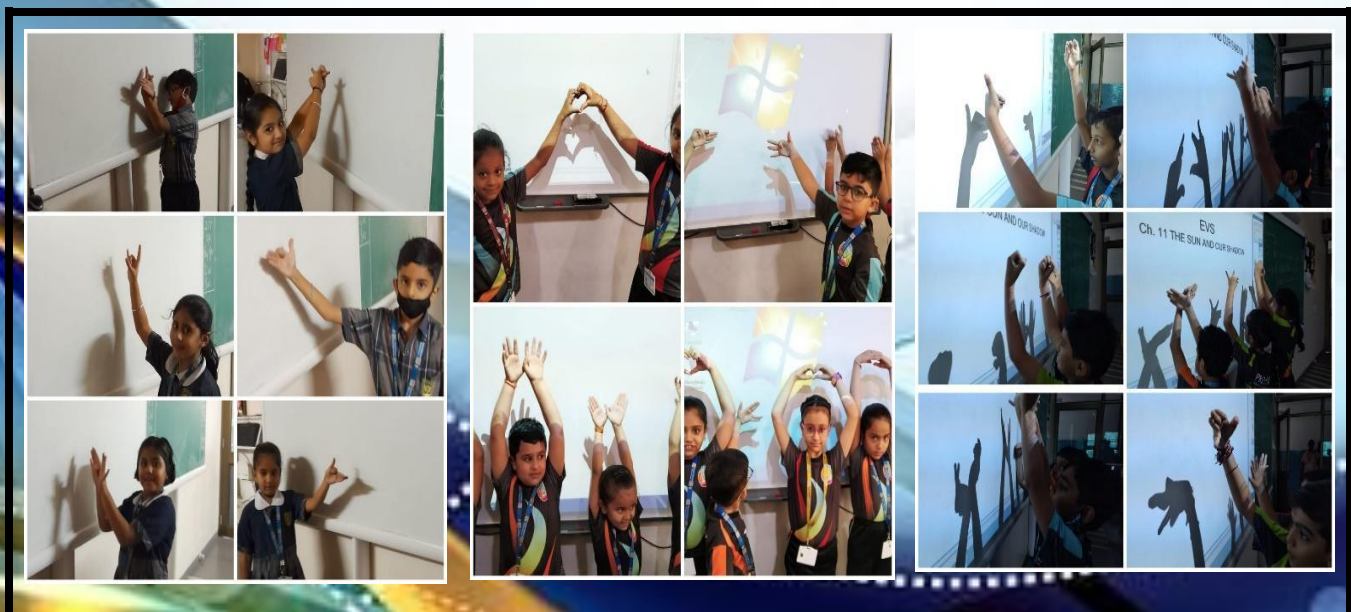
## EXPERIMENT ON FLEXIBLE BODY

## CUBE AND CUBOID ACTIVITY

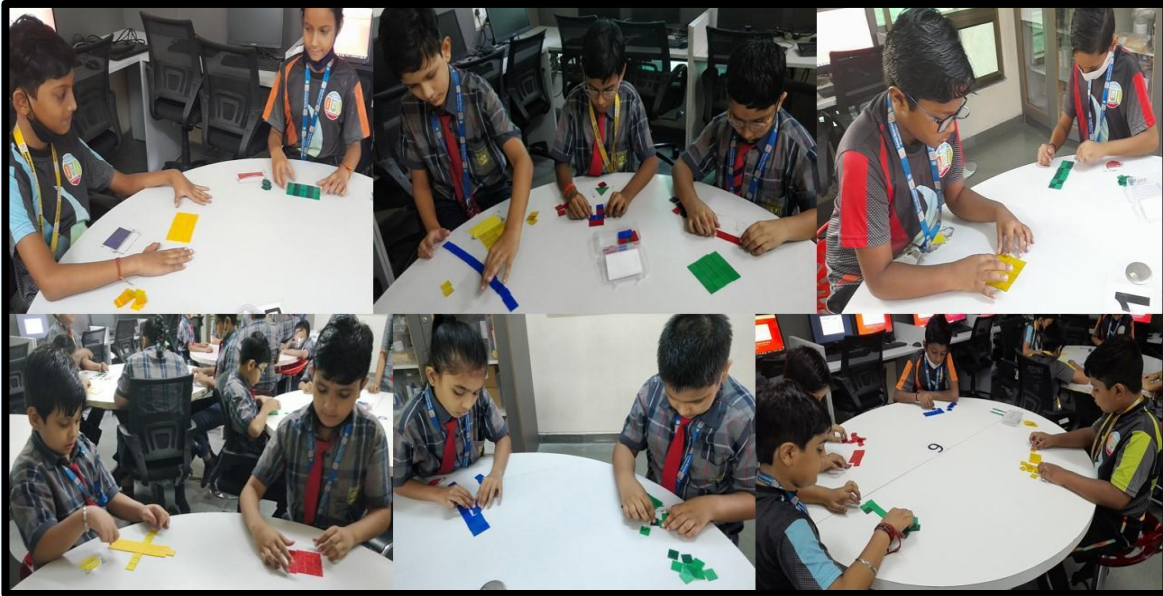

## SOCIAL SCIENCE ACTIVITY

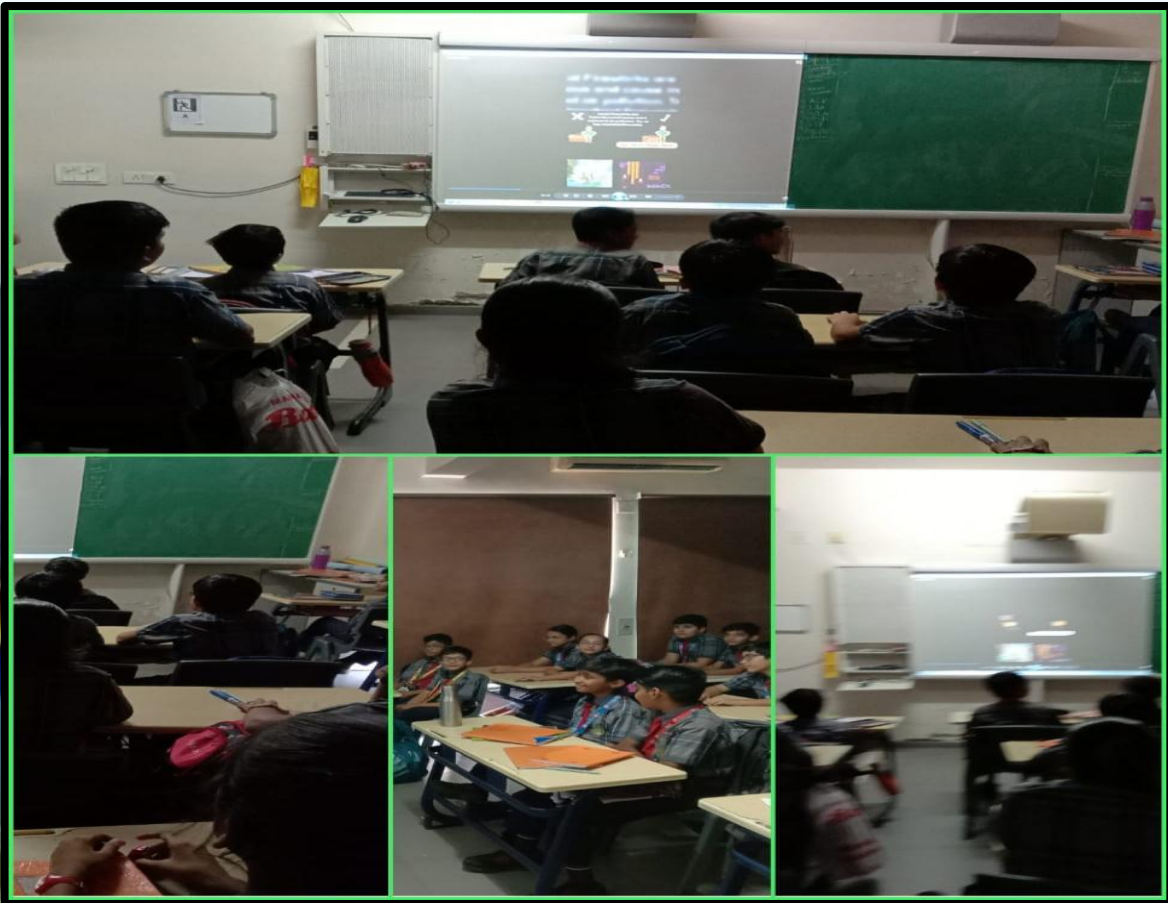

Students enjoyed the video and understood the safety tips to be followed during Diwali.



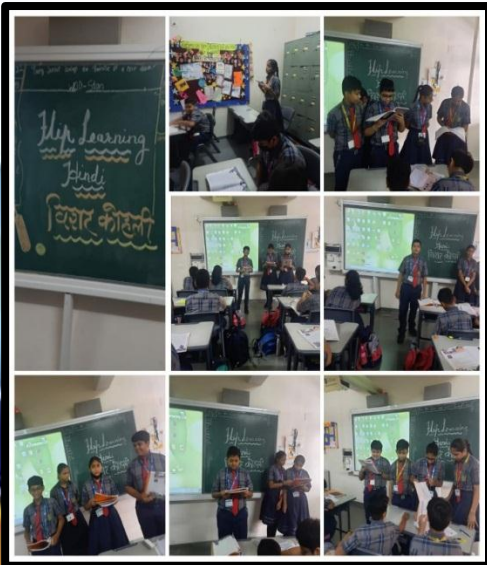


# FLIP LEARNING

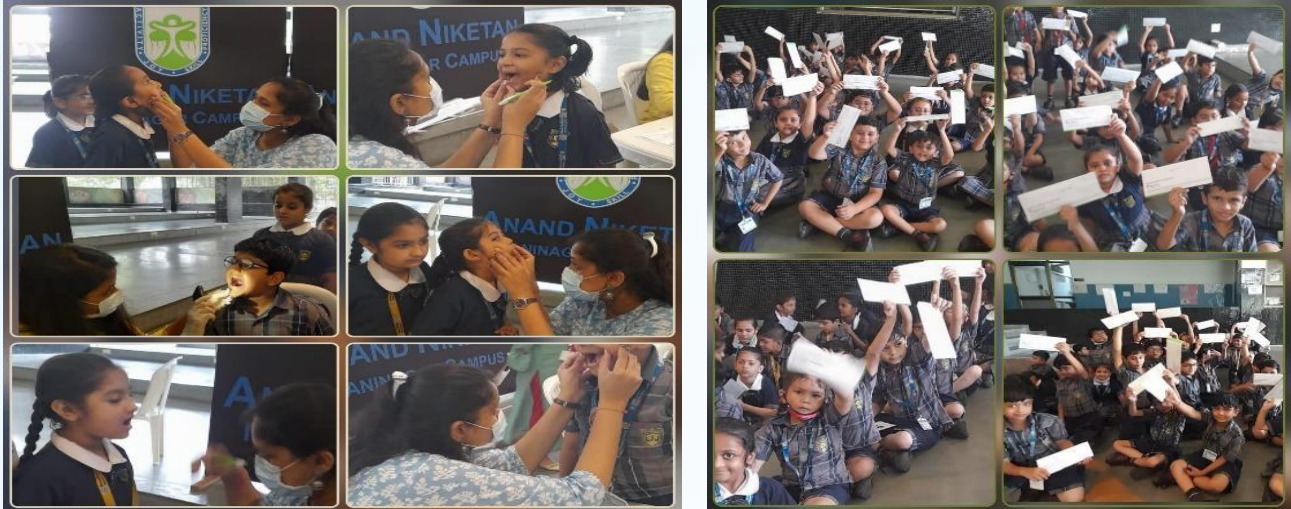
