SCIENCE ACTIVITIES

Types of Clothes Worn & Plant Lap Activity - Seasons and Clothes Science activity was performed by the students of Gr. I. Students have learnt the types of clothes worn during different seasons according to weather conditions. Students have also learnt different parts of plants as Science activity.









Students of Grade – II Animal Wheel Kit - Students of Grade – II performed Animal Wheel Kit activity. They learnt the uses of animals and about the food they eat through the kit in a play way method. Students have also performed "**Tools people use**" science kit activity. They taught the meaning of term **Tools** and learnt to identify, name and connect different kinds of tools used by people for their occupation.







Grade III students learnt how to identify the four main directions North, South, East and West with the help of compass, their location on the map, the different routes, signs and symbols used in different maps.







To understand that different fruits have different number and types of seeds, Science Lab activity was conducted in Gr. III and students explored various fruits they love the most and seeds inside those fruits.





Grade IV students learnt about four main types of teeth: Incisors 2. Canines 3. Premolars 4. Molars their functions, how they help in speaking correct words, chewing food, giving our face its shape.




Grade V performed Science Lab activity on Soil Erosion and learnt about basic concepts of soil erosion.



Grade VI students performed various experiments to learn different methods of separation, understanding the science and the principle behind them. They also learnt the uses of different apparatus used in the Science lab.



Grade VII students performed the Science kit practical on the topic- Sprayer. They learnt the practical application of sprayer in their day to day life.



CODING ACTIVITIES-ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

In the "Artificial Intelligence" education coding sessions students were taught to make their Robot friend and learnt the importance of sorting, sequencing and patterning which are the very basic but core part of learning coding. This helped them understanding computers and learning the basics of coding which will help children to develop an appreciation of how things work.





Students of Gr III and IV used the utensils available at home to understand the concept of **Algorithm**: sorting and sequencing. They came up with their own sorting criteria as well as sequence. Many other students also formed sequence of emoji's in the chat section.



During Gr. V Coding session students practiced algorithm which is a procedure used for solving a problem. They learnt a set of step-by-step instructions to solve a problem i.e. sequencing, selection and interaction. These are the three basic building blocks used as foundation of coding.



HAPPINESS SESSIONS

Grade III & IV - To refresh the young minds in the Happiness Classes of Gr. III different types of claps activity was conducted. Students enjoyed DISCO CLAPs, MONEY CLAPS, FIREWORKS CLAPS. They also did regular breathing activities; what kind of smell they could find around them. For GR IV Mindful activities like move or dance according to the beats of the music (slow, medium, fast), 'Treasure Hunt' helped the students in better blood circulation, reducing stress, anxiety and chances of different diseases.












DIFFERENT SUBJECT ENRICHMENT ACTIVITIES


VIRTUAL FIELD TRIP




